the lead guitar, he always strived for perfection both in the way he played and the way he delivered the final result. When he played rhythm guitar the chords were 100% on the nail and the accompaniment always fitted the tune perfectly. Stephen was a valued member of The Silver Shadows for a period and performed both lead and rhythm guitar with us at the Children In Need concert in
