


THE BURNS COBRA PRIZE DRAW

HAPPY 60th BIRTHDAY STRATOCASTER

This year sees the 60th Anniversary of the Fender Stratocaster Guitar. This iconic guitar was made famous for us when Cliff Richard bought the first Strat into the UK for Hank to play. Several Fender events have been going on at the larger music shops and I was invited to a couple of them to see how the guitars have evolved from the original through to the present model.

Damien Chivers gave a brief history of the guitars development, the most notable players (Hank included) and demonstrated the various models through the years including the latest 2014 range.

After the show we had an informal talk about music, guitars and we all were given a Fender book and a super cool black anniversary shirt.

As a newby to the world of guitar playing I decided to update my Strat copy guitar (£79 including basic amp, gig bag, leads, spare strings and picks).

I opted for a present day US standard model in tobacco sunburst with a rosewood fretboard similar to my old copy strat, sadly when it arrived it had not been set up so out came the book and several hours of tuning began, unfortunately the low E and A strings had a terrible rattling buzz that I could not eliminate despite adjusting the truss rod and raising the action (the gap between the fretboard and the strings), A return to the shop and the guitar was set up by the Luthier to suit my playing and I am very pleased with it although it was initially disappointing compared with my cheap strat copy that only needed tuning and is so reliable for a guitar at less than a tenth the price of the new one.

With hindsight if buying a new guitar get it set up by the shop as it can be disappointing having to take it back to have it set up properly.

Both **Gibson** and **Taylor** guitars have also had roadshows and demonstrations of their new range of products, well worth going along to even if it is just to see the skill of the demonstrators or hearing about the quality of woods and their manufacturing process.
