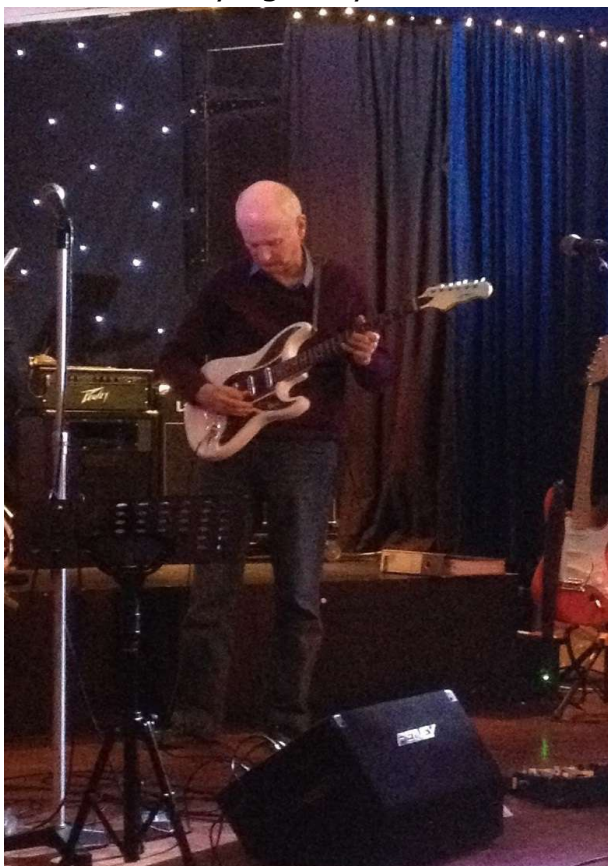
Breakthru' then gave us another round of tunes along with several vocals numbers before the club members had a second chance to play a couple of tunes.

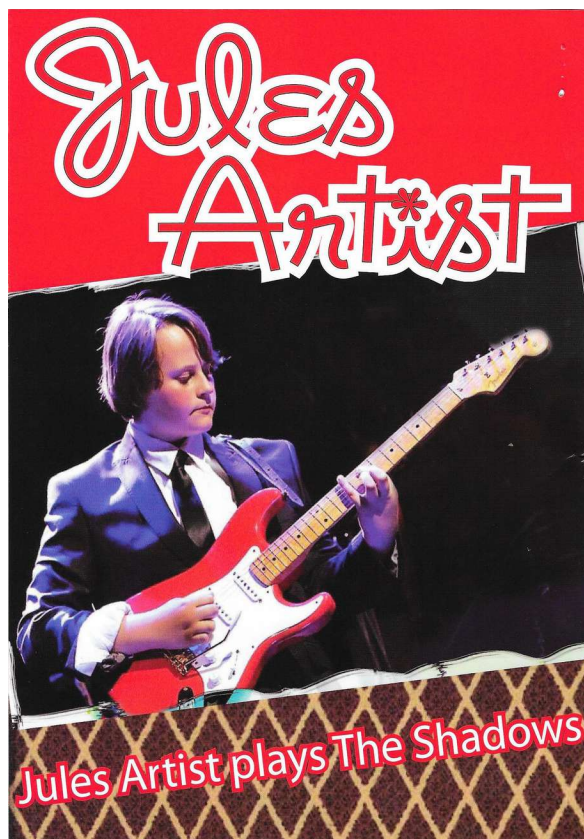
**At our 15th April club meeting

THE TONY MEEHAN BLUE PLAQUE UNVEILING AND LUNCH

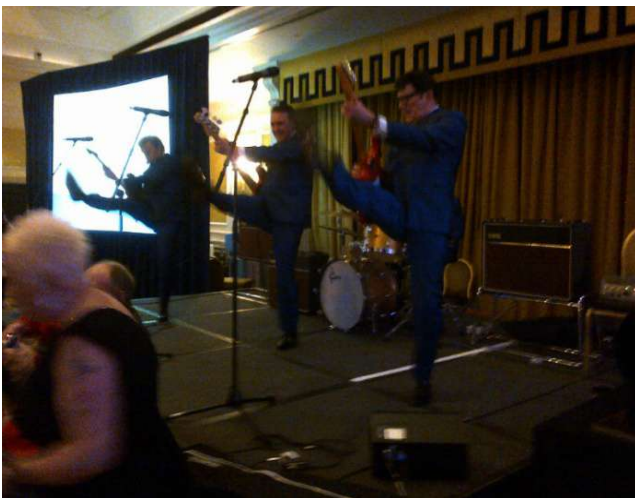
At 12 noon on Sunday 7th February 2016 family, friends and fans of the late Tony Meehan gathered at his home at 34 Lauderdale Mansions, Maida Vale, West London for the unveiling of Tony's Blue Plaque. Following some heart felt words from Bruce Welch the Blue Plaque, which reads



was unveiled by Tony's wife and three of his children assisted by Bruce Welch. However, by the time the count-down from the gathering had reached eight, a strong gust of wind achieved the unveiling for them. As if Tony was saying "come on let's get on with it!"

The party then departed for The London Marriott Hotel – Grosvenor Square, to join all of the other guests attending the Memorial Lunch dedicated to Tony. The whole event was organised by The Heritage Foundation working on behalf of the Arts & Entertainment Charitable Trust, with all profits going to The Bomber Command Association in order to fund the Maintenance of their memorial in Green Park, which was unveiled by Queen Elizabeth on the 28th June 2012.
