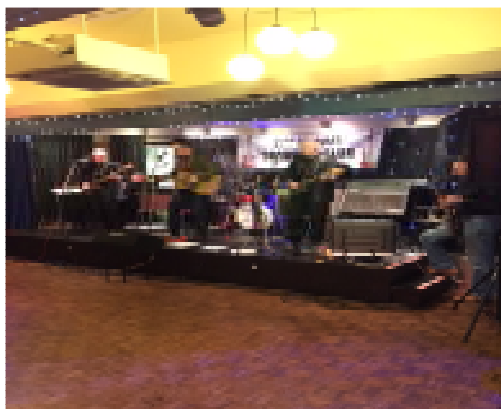
Listening very carefully in the audience was Mr Bruce Welch, which was a great thrill for The Old Ones, as you can see in this photo.
