To go Wi-Fi or not to go Wi-Fi, that is the question

I finally got round to thinking about my Wi-Fi preferences and what options are available; being a close relation of Scrooge the price would also be a big factor.

Sitting indoors being enthralled by Jeremy Kyle, (I don't think) I listed what would best suit my needs. My requirements were fairly simple given that I wanted it for home use, jamming with friends or even an "open mic evening." I didn't want a receiver that needed a power supply, as trying to climb over gear to find a socket can be a bit problematic with the rest of the band.

After a lot of searching the internet and reading up on it, I decided that the JOYO JW-01 was the answer which costs around £60. The transmitter plugs comfortably into the guitar with the receiver going to the input on the amp. Both have Lithium Batteries and recharge from the mains like a mobile phone, with the unit lasting around 10 hours on one charge. It has several other features which I won't bore you with although they can be quite useful.

I purchased the product "online" and when it arrived, I was very pleased with the build quality of the units and charger. After some weeks I contacted **JOYO UK** for advice and found them to be very helpful and they were pleased to assist.

Judging the product even with my Scrooge connections, I think it is great value for money, reliable and supported by a UK team that will always help.

The down side is that is not gig quality and does not kick out as much power as you get using a lead.
