Thank you to **John Bell** for doing the sound.

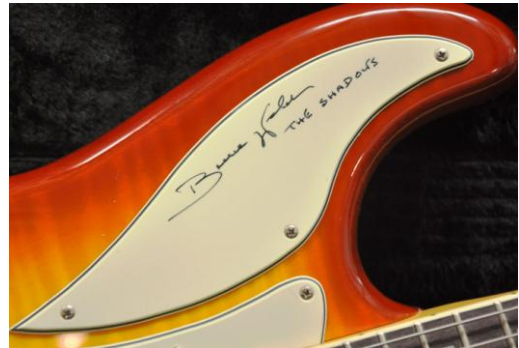

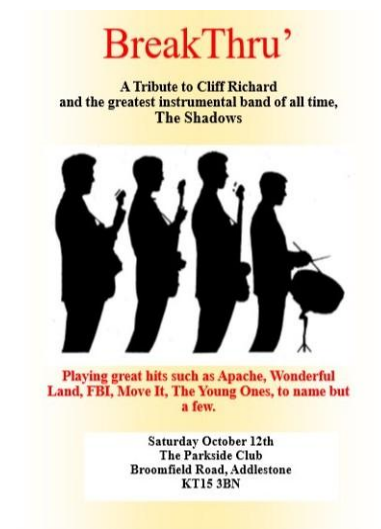
