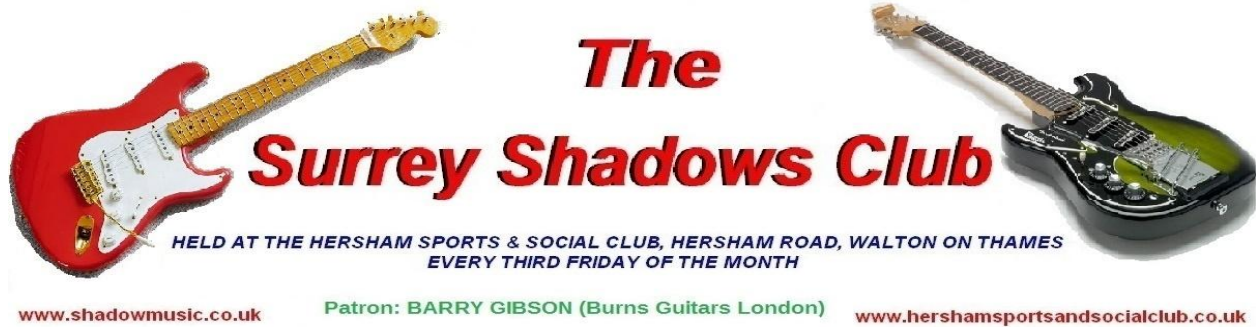


January Newsletter
